## Specific Area: Mathematics

- Uses number names and language spontaneously
- Beginning to represent numbers using fingers, marks on paper or pictures.
- Realises not only objects, but anything can be counted, including steps, claps or jumps.


## Prime Area: Personal Social and

## Emotional Development / Jigsaw

- Seeks out others to share experiences with
- Keeps play going by responding to what others are saying
- Is more outgoing towards unfamiliar people and more confident in new social situations.



## Prime Area: Physical Development

- Uses one-handed tools and equipment, e.g. makes snips in paper with child scissors.
- Holds pencil between thumb and two fingers, no longer using whole-hand grasp. - Can usually manage washing and drying hands.

- Recognises and describes special times or events for family or friends.


## Specific Area: Expressive

## Arts \& Design

- Notices what adults do, imitating what is observed and then doing it spontaneously when the adult is not there.
- Engages in imaginative role-play based on own first-hand experiences.

- Suggests how the story might end.
- Sometimes gives meaning to marks as they draw and paint.
- Shows interest in illustrations and print in books and print in the environment.
