Outcomes to date:

Despite Covid and lockdowns – assessments of the curriculum covered showed children remained on track within the PE curriculum.

Full of Beans worked with children on school in KS1 in small groups to promote both sporting skills and well being of children. This gave the children the opportunity to rebuild relationships and work with an experienced coach on their return not school when the lockdown finished in March 2021.

Unfortunately, due to lockdown there have been no sports clubs in school. This will be addressed as soon as the situation improves with Covid-19.

Children are still taking part in Sports Activities outside of school and this is celebrated in our celebration assemblies – children are involved in dance, swimming, judo and football outside of school.

A revised Sports and Healthy lifestyles week was thoroughly enjoyed by all of the children in their bubbles. 100% 0f pupils took part in the activities which included a revised Sports day, developing games skills, a street dance session, healthy eating and activities using inflatables on the field.

Next Steps/Recommendations:

- Reintroduce after school clubs as the Covid situation improves.
- Get quotes and install a daily mile and other fitness markings across the playground to develop games and fitness outside.
- Get quotes to improve and further develop the fitness trail in the enchanted wood
- Increase the Gymnastic equipment available in PE session for the children ensure that it is KS1 friendly in size and not too big so the children can carry it.
- Reintroduce other activities for Sports and Healthy life style week Covid dependant.
- Monitor SOW and lessons across the school to ensure full coverage and progression
