

Arrangements for September



Start and end of the day – We will be returning to the usual (non-Covid) opening and closing times from September. In the morning the school doors will open at 8.45 and the children can come in from that time up to 8.55. The playground will be open, but we would appreciate it if parents did not congregate in the playaround but drop off and go.

Pre-School will open as usual from 8.45-11.45 and 12.30-3.30. F2 will finish at 3.05pm Year 1 and 2 will leave school at 3.15pm

Uniform – all children will be expected to wear their usual school uniform.

P.E. – Children will continue to come to school on their P.E. days wearing suitable sports clothes for outdoor activities - blue/dark coloured jogging bottoms, t-shirt, hoodie and trainers. The children will not need to wear school uniform on this day and will also not need to bring a pump bag into school.
