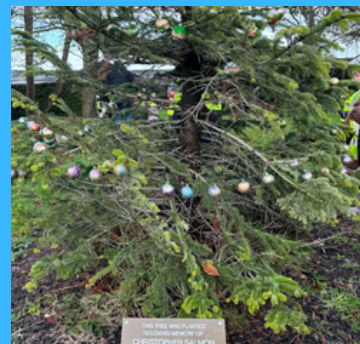
Our 'Elfridges' will take place in school on Monday 9th December. Children can bring in £2 to buy a gift for Mum or Dad.
