HEALTH AND SAFETY INFORMATION

Tummy Bugs It is very important that if your child is absent from school due to a tummy bug they should not return to school for 48 hours after their last bout of sickness or diarrhoea. This is the advice given by the Health Protection Agency to ensure that viruses are not passed from one child to another throughout the whole school community.

Please can you also encourage your child to adopt good hygiene practices, remembering to wash their hands after using the toilet.

COVID-19

Thank you all for all your support throughout this half term. It has been a busy time getting everyone back to school and used to the new routines. The children have been fantastic and are really enjoying being back with their friends and are settling in well.

If your child is absent from school because they have COVID symptoms it is important that they do not come to school and you book a COVID PCR test. Please inform school that they are unwell and let us know the outcome of the test as soon as possible. If the test is negative and they are feeling better, they can return to school. If the test is positive they need to stay off school for at least 10 days and only return if they are feeling better and have not had a fever for at least 24 hours.


