Prime Area: Communication and Language

- Speaking with confidence
- Listening to and joining in with songs and stories
- Joins in with repeated refrains (Little red hen & Farmer duck)
- RWI Phonics

Specific Area: Mathematics

- Counting songs and rhymes about farm animals
- Sort and count farm animals
- Recognise numerals
- Create and experiment with symbols and marks representing ideas of numbers.
- Know that numbers represent how many are in a set.

Prime Area: Personal Social and Emotional Development / Jigsaw

- Can play in a group, extending and elaborating play ideas.
- Initiate play and seek others to share experiences.
- Show confidence when talking to other children and adults, (asking for help).
- Welcomes and values praise

Specific Area:

Understanding the World

- Our homes and families
- Use and explore senses e.g. sounds, textures and smells
- Notice detailed features of objects in the environment.
- Talk about some of the things they observe such as animals
- <u>MfL</u> French

<u>Specific Area:</u> <u>Expressive Arts &</u> <u>Design</u>

- Drawing, painting and collaging farm animals
- Free mark making
- Painting lines and anti clockwise circles
- Mixing colours to make pink for pigs.

Prime Area: Physical Development

- Joins in with finger gym activities and rhymes
- Use indoor and outdoor equipment safely
- Can catch and kick a ball
- Beginning to use tripod grip more often when mark making
- Negotiates spaces successfully, adjusting speed and direction to avoid obstacles.

Specific Area: Literacy

- Recognising own name
- Beginning to identify some initial phonemes of words.
- Retell Little red hen story with puppets
- Begin to make predictions.
