HEALTH AND SAFETY INFORMATION

COVID-19 Update

As I am sure you are all aware, on 27th November, the Prime Minister announced the introduction of temporary new measures as a result of the Omicron variant. These measures are precautionary while the variant is tracked and assessed. In school this means that we have reintroduced the wearing of face coverings for all staff and visitors in communal areas.

At this moment in time, bubbles do not need to be reintroduced and lunchtime procedures, assemblies etc can continue. However if cases increase in school the contingency plan outlines the reintroduction of measures to minimise the mixing between groups.

There are changes to the isolation requirements for confirmed and suspected cases of the Omicron variant and their contacts. All individuals who have been identified as a close contact of a suspected or confirmed case of the Omicron variant, irrespective of vaccination status and age, will be contacted directly and required to self isolate immediately and asked to book a PCR test. Close contacts will be identified by NHS Test and Trace. Schools are not expected to undertake contact tracing.

For cases of Covid-19 which are not the new Omicron variant, isolation rules remain unchanged. Individuals are not required to self-isolate if they live in the same household as someone with Covid-19 (not Omicron variant) or a close contact as long as they have been fully vaccinated, are below the age of 18 years, are taking part in an approved vaccination trial or unable to vaccinated for medical reasons.

We ask the parents and children follow public health advice and not come into school if they have symptoms, have had a positive test result or have been contacted and asked to self-isolate. We want to minimise the risk of passing on the virus to others in our school community.

Christmas Concerts—We are currently planning to continue with our Christmas concerts and invite parents to join us. However we will need to put some restrictions in place in order to minimise risk, as we did earlier this term for our Harvest Festival and Curriculum Afternoons. We ask that only one parent per family attends the performance and that they wear a face covering. We ask that you sanitise your hands on arrival and if possible take a LFT the day before. Obviously if you have any symptoms, please do not attend.

We need to have a record of visitors to school and therefore ask that you email the school office to confirm your attendance at the concert. If your child is in Foundation 2, we ask that where possible you attend on Tuesday 14th at 1.30 if your child is in Mrs Stocker's class and Wednesday 15th at 9.15 if your child is in Mrs Whelan and Miss Thurgood's class. Pre-School parents should attend on the day their child is in Pre-School. This way we will be able to accommodate one parent per family in a Covid-safe manner.

However if circumstances in school change and we experience a significant rise in cases, or if Wirral Public Health/DfE advice changes, we may need to withdraw parental invitations and put recordings of the performances on Tapestry instead. I hope that we do not have to do this as everyone is looking forward to being able to celebrate Christmas in school this year.
